


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## 1.0 MAPS





Figure 1: The location of the Madill site (BaHb-17) on part Lot 12, Concession 3 (Old Survey), Township of Melancthon. Base map: NTS Dundalk sheet 41 A/1, Edition 5, 1999.

Re: Intent to Protect the Madill site (BaHb-17) within the Strada Aggregates Melancthon Pit Extension, Part of west half of Lots 12 and 14, Concession 3 (O. S.), Township of Melancthon

Please accept this letter as our commitment to carrying out activities in support of the recommendation that the Strada Aggregates Melancthon Pit Extension is partially clear of concern with respect to archaeological resources with demonstrated cultural heritage value or interest. It is anticipated that site preparation activities on that part of the property without archaeological concerns will commence in the summer of 2018. We request that the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport provide a letter confirming that there are no further concerns within the remainder of the property where no archaeological sites were documented.

Before any activity begins for which earth moving is required, the Madill site (BaHb-17) will be protected with a high visibility fence that includes a 10 m buffer as a temporary protection measure. Instructions will be issued to Strada Aggregates personnel with respect to avoidance of the archaeologically sensitive area. The protective measures will remain in place until the Stage 4 archaeological salvage excavation is completed. A licensed archaeologist will be retained to monitor the activity to verify that the avoidance and temporary protection measures are being carried out. The archaeological consultant will be empowered to stop construction if there is concern for impacts to the archaeological site.

The outstanding Stage 4 archaeological salvage excavations are expected to begin at the start of the 2018 field season.
