First steps would be to speak with the Conservation Authorities to determine what is in our area and create an inventory list of our concerns. There is an invasive species website that could also help narrow down to our area.

The County is building a plan to deal with things they believe will be coming to our area and will plan for different scenarios. It was noted that it seems to be a 10 year cycle, numbers climb then they peak and then the numbers come down and this repeats every 10 years. A reactive approach can be expensive but education and assistance to

the taxpayers can be a cheaper option. There is a Phragmites group on Facebook called Phrag Fighters Dufferin County, this is a volunteer group trying to educate people with great resources.

Discussion about illegal dumping, sustainable buildings and scrap yards and effects they have on the environment. Also discussed building and bringing in fill. This committee will make recommendations to Council with issues brought forward on all environmental topics, everything is worth considering.

Recommendation for February 18 Council meeting to include a closed session item regarding Northern Iron and Metal concerns.

Would like to have a delegation attend the next meeting in March. Request was for Caroline Mach, County Forest Manager and a member of the NVCA to discuss Melancthon area issues.
