

As a follow up to our delegation at the Township of Melancton Roads Committee Meeting held on March 1, 2023, the Township of Southgate formally expresses interest in purchasing 200 metres of the unopened road allowance at the corner of lot 241 and King's Highway 10 to create an entrance between lots 240 and 241:

The road will be built to County of Grey standards as it has been identified as a potential future by-pass around the main street in Dundalk.
